

Sponsorship Terms and Conditions

- 1) Website or blog must have existed for at least ONE year.
 - 2). Website or blog must have traffic rank above 5,000,000 calculated using a combination of average daily visitors and page-views over the past three months.
 - A) Social community sites or non-profit organizations are exempted from sections **1** and **2**.
 - B) Companies who do not meet the requirement of section **1** and **2** would be reviewed subjectively by the discretion of the management criteria.
 - 3) Webserver.com.my does not accept any website that contain information that is likely to incite hatred or that constitutes or encourages discrimination based on ethnicity, race, sexuality, religion, political affiliation or otherwise information that promotes or facilitate illicit activities such as intimidation, pornographic, terrorism, violence, defamatory, or pertain sensitive content that are actionable at law.
 - 4) The minimum period of hosting sponsorship is 12 months.
 - A) Webserver shall have the right in its sole discretion, to terminate the sponsorship at any time should section 3 of the terms and conditions be violated
 - 5) Recipient must write to Webserver.com.my through email for renewal of hosting sponsorship prior to 60 days before the expiry date.
 - 6) Webserver.com.my should not be held liable for any losses, damages or lawsuit that may occur on the website or blog.
 - 7) This sponsorship shall not include the registration of domain name.
 - 8) Webserver.com.my shall be permitted to make reference to the recipient's website (logo) for any offline or online publication in future.
